Body

Noam Federman, spokesman for Kach before he was arrested and placed in administration detention six months ago, is scheduled to be released from the Sharon Prison in Tel Mond this morning.

Federman was one of the two central figures in Kach before that organization was banned in March, following the Hebron massacre.

The other key Kach figure, **Baruch** Marzel, is due to be released in about three weeks. Federman will go from the Sharon Prison this morning to Jerusalem's Misgav Ladach Hospital, where his wife gave birth to a son Sunday morning.

Federman's release brings to three the number of Kach and Kahane Hai activists still in administrative detention: Marzel, **Baruch Ben-Yosef** and Shmuel **Ben**-Ya'acov. Nine Kach and Kahane Hai activists were placed in administrative detention soon after the massacre.
